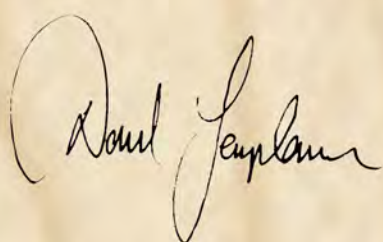

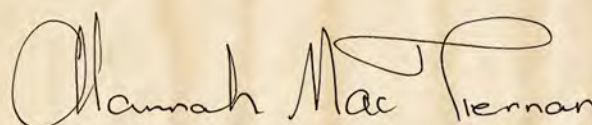
Tourism is a key part of the Government's plan to energise the economy, create jobs and develop business opportunities, especially in regional Western Australia.

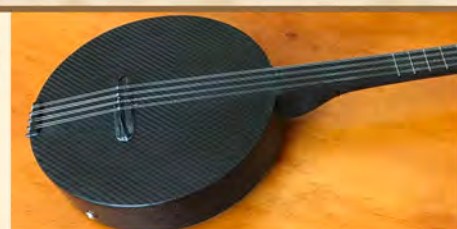

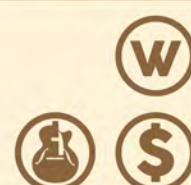
